Description of Program Services: The Sally's House program provides emergency shelter and transitional housing to homeless adults, giving them an opportunity to work on their life challenges such as alcohol or drug addictions and poor life choices. In Life Skills classes, residents establish goals for themselves in managing their funds, housing, and health.

Impact Area: Health

Significant Statistics: In 2016, the EscaRosa Coalition on the Homeless reported the daily estimated homeless population for our area was 796; approximately half of them have drug, alcohol, or physical issues.
